Early Pathways & Restorative Relationships



The Kick-Off class is a mandatory part of the Diversion Program and is run by BoldLeaders, a non-profit education organization. The class is offered monthly and instructions on how to sign up online are below. In order to complete your diversion contract on time, you will need to attend the class as soon as possible. Failure to attend the class may result in your case being referred back to the County/City Attorney's Office. If you sign-up for a class and are unable to attend, you must notify BoldLeaders prior to the day of the class.

During the class, participants will have time to write an apology letter to the person(s) or organization that they have harmed, and they will also have time to identify a personal quality about themselves they would like to develop further during the program. Parents are not required to attend – the class is for the juvenile diversion participant only.

Be sure to sign-up for the right class: the Restorative Relationships Class is for High School Students; the Early Pathways Class is for Elementary and Middle School Students. You may need to use tabs to go through the form. Be sure to click submit at the bottom of the page. After signing-up, we will send you a confirmation email (within 48 hours) and alert your Diversion Officer that you have enrolled.

You will need to select and enroll for the class date and time that you have been instructed to by your diversion officer (You will only attend one class):
