

Jail Nurse

The Hall County Department of Corrections is seeking full-time jail nurses to provide health services for individuals detained at our facility. Candidates must at minimum possess a license to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the State of Nebraska at the time of appointment. Jail nurses serve as professional nurses in the county corrections facility that perform a variety of nursing duties in a correctional setting, exercising considerable independent judgment in all aspects of the medical program under the direction of the Nursing supervisor. This position supports and collaborates with Department of Corrections staff to ensure that health needs are identified and treated.
