

Hall County Sheriff's Office Now Hiring for Deputy Sheriff

The Hall County Sheriff's Office is currently accepting applications for the position of Deputy Sheriff. Applicants must meet the following requirements: 21 years old by date of appointment, high school graduate or equivalent, good driving record with the ability to obtain a valid Nebraska Driver's License. Must also pass written, oral board, physical fitness, psychological exams, drug screening, and a thorough background investigation. Must be able to pass all entry requirements of the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center. Wages are on a 9-step pay scale: currently \$30.64 to \$43.15 per hour, and comes with a complete Benefit Package. Hall County is EOE and does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age or disability in employment or provision of services. Veteran's preference is available.
